Who pays for this program?

The manufacturers (brand owners) and importers of designated electronic equipment cover 100% of the costs of the electronic waste program. These companies (also known as "Stewards") are required to register, report and pay fees to OES based on their share of the annual cost to operate the program.

Is the fee a tax?

The fees are not a tax. OES sets the fees annually to cover the program's cost. Government does not set the fees and none of the fees collected go to the government. All fees collected by OES go towards covering the program's costs to collect, transport, consolidate and process waste electronics. In additions, funds are used for public education and awareness, research and development, continuous improvements in technology and program execution.

Why are EHF's being reduced as of August 1st, 2011?

OES constantly reviews fees charged to Stewards to ensure that they cover the current recycling program costs and targets. We have determined that we are able to make a downward adjustment on fees charged to Stewards at this time.
